Form of Play : **REPGT Individual Division** – Stableford (gross section and net section)

Guest Division – New New Peoria

<u>Handicap</u>: REPGT handicap indices will be used (max 28 for men & 32 for ladies)

Index Player without REPGT handicap indexes – as declared (max 20 for men

& 28 for ladies)

<u>Maximum</u>: <u>Maximum strokes</u> for each hole by a player is <u>4 over par</u>

Stroke (i.e. 7 for Par 3's, 8 for Par 4's and 9 for Par 5's)

<u>Tee</u> : Men – White, Ladies – Red

<u>Longest Drive</u>: To be announced

<u>Closest-to-pin</u>: To be announced

Rules

The Rules of Golf of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews as adjusted by any local rules will apply.

Gimmie:

Ball within one putter length (rubber grip not included) to the hole will be regarded as hole-out on addition of <u>One Stroke</u> (i.e. no need to putt, add one stroke). The measuring putter should be the shortest putter used by a player in the flight.

Players should consult his/her marker in case of doubt. If still undecided, play a second ball, record both scores and consult the Committee after the round.

Drop zones:

All Drop Zones are in used (add ONE penalty stroke)

Count-Back

In the event of a tie, the result will be decided by the following count back procedure: -

Stableford

For Stableford scorings, count back system will be 9-6-3-1 (i.e. compare the Stableford points of back 9 holes, then front 9 holes, then last 6 holes, then middle 6 holes etc etc). The same applies to both Gross and Net sections.

New New Peoria (NNP)

Count back system will be NNP handicap (i.e. player with lowest NNP handicap will win), then "9-6-3-1" applies (i.e. compare the gross strokes of back 9 holes, then front 9 holes, then last 6 holes, then middle 6 holes etc etc). If a winner is still not determined, the result will be decided by the toss of a coin.

Scorecards

Players must mark his/her actual scores on the score card to a maximum of 4 over par for each hole (i.e. the maximum score one should record is 7 for Par 3's, 8 for Par 4's, and 9 for Par 5's).

Players must exchange score cards with his/her named marker. Both player and marker should check and agree upon the scores after the round and both sign on the cards before turning them in to the tournament Scorer. Any amendment/alteration must be countersigned by the marker.

Properly completed scorecards are to be submitted to the Scorer as soon as possible and not more than 15 minutes after the round. Scorecard <u>not properly completed</u> will be treated as <u>void</u> and the player will be <u>disqualified</u>

Slow Play

To avoid slow play, players should:

- ➤ Keep up with the flight ahead,
- Always play a provisional ball if in doubt; and
- ➤ Mark the <u>maximum stroke</u> (4 over par) in the scorecard and pick-up if cannot score any Stableford point in any hole.
