Seminar and Technical Visit - Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Facilities

A trend of using electric vehicle (EV) has been developed in Hong Kong. The availability of chargers, especially in the properties, is critical and contributory to the rapid and continuous development of the EV market. CLP Power has pioneered the introduction of charging facilities across its power supply network since 2009. Apart from expanding the EV charging network throughout CLP Power's service areas, they recently launched a one-stop "333 EV Power Supply Support" service, offering a more user-friendly option for drivers intending to install EV charging facilities at parking spaces in residential or commercial buildings.

Our Institute has organized an activity supported by CLP Power Hong Kong Ltd., which including a sharing session on their experience of developing and setting-up the EV charging facilities in the properties of private sector and a visit on their latest charging facilities.
