#### Minutes

## 3) The Chairman's Report

2018 was a very important and challenging year for the Chartered Institute of Housing Asian Pacific Branch (CIHAPB). We have fruitful achievements in our works, including professional development in the Asia Pacific region, collaboration with UK headquarters in change of operation mode of CIHAPB in Hong Kong and Mainland China, professional sharing, management of membership promotion, etc. At the same period of time, we have maintained close connection with our members and others professional bodies to express professional views on new legislation about property-management-related areas, encourage the experience sharing among them, enhancing service delivery and professionalism and expand our membership base.

Chairman thanked Executive Committee for their contributions to provide their expertise views during the public consultation of the new legislation concerned, enhance the service level of property management and be recognized by the industry in the Asia Pacific region.

Some of our achievements we have accomplished in 2018 are reported as below:

3.1 Property Management Services Ordinance

In 2018, CIHAPB has actively involved on the public consultation of the licensing regime on property management practitioners with the Property Management Services Authority. We have also teamed up with fellow professional housing institutes to organize forums and seminars for members.

3.2 Strengthening Communication with Professional Institutes in Different Countries and Regions

It is opportune for CIHAPB to set objectives to tie in with the internationalization process and the "The Belt and Road Initiative" for membership drive and service delivery to our members, we would further strengthen our contacts with professionals and institutes in the Asia Pacific region.

#### 3.3 Professional Development

In 2018, CIHAPB has continued to adhere to our mission of promoting professionalism to continue to advocate the professional development in the Asia Pacific region and to contribute in bringing up the professional standards of the industry. CIHAPB held a number of seminars, workshops, professional forums, site visits and other activities to provide members with new management practices and service information so as to enhance members' professional knowledge.

3.4 Enhancing Member Services

In 2018, our membership had a growth of more than 5.5%. The major increase segment was in Mainland China as a result of our enhancement of membership services and collaborations with our training partners in this region. Opportunities were taken by CIHAPB to explore areas of membership expansion in Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan.

3.5 Learning and Promoting New Technology

Environmental-friendly, BIM and BEAM initiatives, Green Building and Management with application of new technologies alike provided the industry with management efficiency improvements. As Mainland China has demonstrated a great progress in this aspect, learning and experience sharing from advancement in this area would benefit members of CIHAPB.

#### 4) Financial Statement

#### 4.1 Financial Report

Mrs. Li Lam Chin Ching, Rita, the Honorary Treasurer, reported that the financial situation of the CIHAPB for the Year 2018 in which membership fee of about HK\$3.07M was received from members. The total expenditure in 2018 was about HK\$2.6 M and the income, other than membership fees in 2018 was about HK\$0.96M. Hence, APB continued to be a net contributor with a surplus of about HK\$1.4M to CIHHQ in 2018.

Prudent fiscal practice would be continuously adopted for a financially healthy Year 2019.
