Invitation to EVS25 HK EV Parade and Exhibition

I am writing to invite you to be our Guest at the upcoming Electric Vehicle (EV) Parade and Exhibition.

CLP is launching the first and largest EV Parade and Exhibition of its kind in the territory on 11 November 2010 to demonstrate and educate the public of the feasibility, performance, and environmental benefits of EVs. 
