I am pleased to inform you that the Centre of Urban Studies and Urban Planning (CUSUP) of the University of Hong Kong and the Centre for China Urban and Regional Studies (CURS) of Hong Kong Baptist University are jointly organizing the *International Conference on China Urban Development* at the University of Hong Kong from 7-8 December 2010 to commemorate the 100th Anniversary of the University of Hong Kong, 30th Anniversary of the CUSUP of the University of Hong Kong and 10th Anniversary of the CURS of Hong Kong Baptist University. Keynote speakers include Dr. Qiu Baoxing, Vice-Minister, Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development, Prof. Zou Deci, Academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering, and Prof. John Logan of Brown University, USA and Founder of the Urban China Research Network. Mrs. Carrie Lam, Secretary for Development of the Development Bureau of the Hong Kong SAR Government, will be giving a welcoming address at the Opening Ceremony of the Conference. 
