Mr. Jeff Tung is a Hong Kong Registered Architect and a Fellow Member of Hong Kong Institute of Architects. He graduated from HKU in 1985 and has been working in the building industry for more than 30 years, with over 10 years in the Private Development sector. He has extensive experience in the planning, architectural design and project management of commercial and hotel projects in Hong Kong, China and Southeast Asia.

In one of his most remarkable projects, Grand Hyatt HK, water features have been integrated into the landscape and interior design respectively as decorative elements; they successfully become the focuses, and enliven the space with sound, light, movement and reflection. Mr. Tung is currently managing the remodeling of New World Centre into Victoria Dockside, where water has been widely used as both an environmental and visual elements for the users to enjoy.

Mr. Tony Cheung holds the Diploma of Design of Urban Waters from Harvard Graduated School of Design. In his 40 years of water feature design and construction experience, some of his remarkable projects include Gulin Lijiang Waterfall Hotel, World's Biggest Man Make Waterfall in the Guinness Book of Records 2001, and Suntec City Singapore, World's Largest Fountain in the Guinness Book of Records 1998.

In the past decades, Mr. Cheung has designed, constructed and maintained over 1500 water features in over 500 projects ranging from parks, hotels, resorts, shopping malls, office buildings, estates and private residences, with his footprints over China, Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan, Philippine, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia and United Arab Emirate.
