

Urban Renewal Strategy – Concluding Forum

Background

Early this year, the Hong Kong Institute of Real Estate Administrators (HIREA) has participated in the Partnership Organization Programme (POP) on the Review of Urban Renewal Strategy and established a Special Task Force Committee to gauge the views on our members as well as those of three other allied professional institutions, viz. Hong Kong Association of Property Management Companies Ltd (HKAPMC), Hong Kong Institute of Housing (HKIH) and Chartered Institute of Housing Asian Pacific Branch (CIHAPB), on key matters and issues relating to the urban regeneration. The objective of our participation is to facilitate the Government in revamping the captioned policy and shaping the future urban regeneration modalities.

Objectives

We have carried out a Written Survey to solicit the views of members of the above Institutions and have also conducted an Engagement Forum in the middle of this year with over 120 attendees to seek their views. A comprehensive report will be submitted to the Government before the end of this year after a Concluding Forum has been conducted in November 2009.

It is our wish that this report will help the Government shape a new urban renewal strategy which would be sustainable and met the needs and aspirations of our community.
