Introduction :

The Shatin Communications and Technology Centre (SCTC) is significant to the Hong Kong Jockey Club in supporting to business growth and to deliver a new and better world-class working environment for staff with environmental-friendly building facilities. It brings together a series of core operations within an improved, more sustainable environment which caters to the long-term operational requirements of the Club.

Measuring a gross floor area of over 50,000 m², the new facility has been a significant undertaking for the Property-Facilities Management team of the Hong Kong Jockey Club. The building accommodates the Club's Main Telebet Centre, an Integrated Call Centre, the IT Department, Broadcasting Department facilities including their television studios, and a Hong Kong Jockey Club College for ongoing development of Club employees.

With a strong focus on sustainability, this building contains a lot of green and advanced features and the project is certified for BEAM Plus Gold and LEED Gold certification.
