Programme Highlights

"Super Typhoon Mangkhut" passed next to Hong Kong and Macau on 16 September 2018. It was the strongest to hit Hong Kong in the record of the past 50 years causing large scale damage around the city on transportation systems, commercial and residential Buildings and Casinos etc. in Hong Kong and Macau respectively. Most of the typhoon precautionary measures were taken by the practitioners of facilities management especially the Technical Department of operation & maintenance (O&M) industry for managing and preventing any potential risks, implementing typhoon duty working procedures, contingency plan and emergency handling, post water flooding crisis management etc. The Organizers invited three (3) Honourable Speakers to share their precious experience in leading their Typhoon Team with some case studies for easy illustration.
