Programme Highlights

In addition to the effort made by the registered contractors, engineers, workers and regulatory body, owners or management companies also play a pivot role to achieve high quality and safety performance of lifts and escalators. In December 2012, "Lifts and Escalators Ordinance (Cap. 618)" was enacted to repeal the previous Lifts and Escalators (Safety) Ordinance (Cap. 327). One of the new statutory amendments is to stipulate the duties of "Responsible Person", who has the management and control on lifts and escalators. To assist Responsible Person to fulfill the duties and understand more about the working principles, BSOMES has set up a voluntary taskforce to prepare a manual of "Best Management Practices on Operation & Maintenance for Lifts and Escalators". In this seminar, the speakers will share the best management practices on operation and maintenance for lifts and escalators. At the beginning of seminar, a simple but grant ceremony to launch the Manual will be officiated by Guest of Honour, i.e. Director of Electrical and Mechanical Services, Mr. Alfred Sit, JP.
