Programme Highlights	:	It is an unusual time to raise a topic about Household Drainage System again, for the outbreak of COVID-19. In the long run, CIPHE wish to share and review with our engineers the design, installation and maintenance of the drainage system to stop the cross contamination among apartments of a building. Today, we would introduce our findings on potential defects or failures in existing systems and the immediate remedies.		
		Generally believed, the spread of virus can be caused by air contamination, when sewage-polluted air from a sanitary fixture gets into other apartments through the same shared drainage system. Indeed, drainage systems of a building must be equipped with appropriate traps, built with specified depth of water seal by Regulation to stop the air from drainage system entering the apartments. This protection can be broken by one or more of the following reasons:		
		<ol> <li>Water seal being broken by pressure in the drainage pipe.</li> <li>Water seal being removed from the position.</li> <li>Failed trap(s).</li> <li>Negative pressure (High enough to overcome the water seal) existing inside the washroom / kitchen (The Room).</li> </ol>		
		<ul> <li>Item 1 to 3 might happen for different reasons. This Seminar is brought to you with:</li> <li>A. A brief introduction of drainage systems and their major components.</li> <li>B. Reasons of protection breakage and recommendation of remedies.</li> <li>Item 4 should normally not happen but it is a good practice to avoid closing all windows and door of the Room while turning on the ventilation fan or cooker</li> </ul>
