Unravelling a Ticking Bomb – Proper Building Management and Maintenance of Aged Buildings

Background

The building collapse incident in Hung Hom in January 2010 has not only attracted wide attention across the community, but has also triggered an alarm bell, particularly for the land-related professionals, on the adequacy of existing legislation and control measures to ensure proper management and maintenance of multi-storey and multi-ownership buildings. Should we not take immediate actions to redress the problem, this fiasco might be just a small tip of a much larger iceberg. Notwithstanding that the Government has promptly conducted inspection of all buildings of over 50 years old, the building decay problem is still seriously haunting the community.

Objectives

In response to this undesirable situation, Hong Kong Professional Property Services Alliance (HKPPSA) (comprising Hong Kong Association of Property Management Companies (HKAPMC), Hong Kong Institute of Housing (HKIH), Chartered Institute of Housing Asian Pacific Branch (CIHAPB), and Hong Kong Institute of Real Estate Administrators (HIREA)) is organizing a joint seminar to collate the views of our members in the context of proper building management and maintenance, including the adequacy of existing legislation and its enforcement, and the supporting measures and public education being implemented, with a view to consolidating the views and recommendations of our members for submission to the Government.

We are much honoured to have invited Mrs. Carrie Lam, JP, Secretary for Development, to deliver an opening speech at the seminar to inspire us on the problems of aged buildings.

As many of our members are actively engaged in the field of building management and maintenance, it is our aspiration that the HKPPSA, through the confluence of our professional views, could assist the Government in shaping a timely strategy to resolve this long-standing problem.
