## Technical Talk: Elevator Systems for Super High-Rise Buildings 11 November 2017 (Saturday)

Chartered Institute of Housing Asian Pacific Branch (CIHAPB) and Urban Research Group, Department of Public Policy, City University of Hong Kong have jointly organized a talk as follows:

<b>Contents</b>	It is a general trend due to urbanization that buildings are getting taller and taller in megacities. To provide a satisfactory vertical transportation service to these buildings, elevators are running faster and faster. At the same time, the conventional one-car-per-hoistway concept has to be changed as it is wasting vertical space seriously. Recently, the concept of two-dimensional elevator systems has become real. In the future, it may get to three dimensional. In the presentation, both issues will be discussed, in terms of passenger demand, safety, and recent development of technology.
<b>Speaker</b>	<b>Ir Dr Albert T So (BSc, MPhil, PhD, CEng, RPE)</b> Ir Dr So is the Director of Asian Institute of Built Environment, and honorary visiting professor of University of Northampton in elevator engineering. He founded the (IAEE) International Association of Elevator Engineers (HK-China Branch) in 1993 and is now Academic Secretary. He is also the Scientific Advisor and Executive Board Member of IAEE at the European headquarters. He has published over 40 articles on elevator engineering.
