

Seminar on Upcoming Building Assessment & Inspection Schemes for Building Professionals

INTRODUCTION

In support of the “Mandatory Building Inspection Scheme” (MBIS) and the “Mandatory Window Inspection Scheme” (MWIS) to be launched later this year, the Hong Kong Housing Society was commissioned by the Government to undertake the implementation of the “Voluntary Building Assessment Scheme” (VBAS) with the objectives to encourage property owners to properly manage and maintain their buildings on their own initiatives. All private domestic and composite (domestic and commercial) buildings or developments are welcome to join the VBAS. Buildings certified under the VBAS will be recognized by the Buildings Department for having fulfilled the requirements under the MBIS and MWIS (in respect of windows in common parts only) within the respective inspection cycles.

This Seminar aims to provide details of the various upcoming building assessment and inspection schemes for building professionals who may wish to become VBAS Assessors and Registered Inspectors under these schemes.

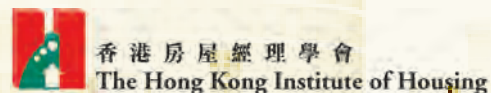
